

Butt joint margin I.0-mm reduction at gingival margin Butt joint margin I.5-mm lingual contact clearance to 1.5-mm facial reduction I.5-mm to 2.0-mm incisal reduction Football-shaped finishing bur

3-UNIT BRIDGE PREPARATION


VENEER PREPARATION

medium grit, round-ended, diamond bur is used to remove a uniform thickness of facial enamel by joining the depth-cut grooves.




INCISAL PREPARATION

The diamond bur is angled to bevel back the incisal edge.



CHAMFER MARGINS

Correct preparation of the chamfer margins interproximally allows the appropriate bulk of porcelain.
